

#### **Battery Recharging:**

- . Connect the small plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the Micro USB Port on the unit.
- 2. Connect the full sized USB plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the USB Port on the Personal Computer or USB Charger (Computer and USB Charger not included) as illustrated below:




