TEMPERATURE SETTING

TEMPERATURE SETTINO There are two Low heat (750 W) power switches. Pressing either one will give you Low heat. You need to press both Low heat (750 W) buttons at the same time to get High heat (1500 W). Oscillation Function: This model is equipped with an oscillation feature. If you want to obtain a wider area of heat circulation, press button for oscillation function.

When returned to normal upright position, heat will automatically come on again. This is a safety feature to avoid possibility of a fire should the unit be accidentally tipped over.

CLEANING/MAINTENANCE 1. Before any cleaning, make sure that: A) The heater is turned OFF and cool to the touch. B) Disconnect power supply at source by removing plug from power outlet. 2. Regular Cleaning: A) Interior dust can often be removed by using a vacuum cleaner with a crevice tool attachment. B) Do not use cleaning spray-on liquids or other chemicals on the unit. O Use a clean, soft and lightly damp cloth to gently wipe off the dirt from the surface of the unit. Be sure not to wet the heating element and the switches. Allow the unit to dry completely here using mpletely before using.

CAUTION: DO NOT ALLOW WATER TO RUN INTO THE INTERIOR OF THE HEATER AS THIS COULD CREATE A FIRE OR ELECTRIC SHOCK HAZARD.
